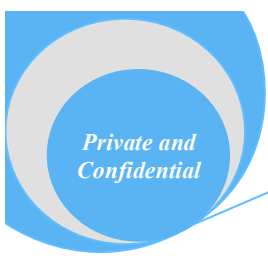

A detailed list of what personal items to bring to the camp and a timetable of all our activities during the camp is provided on our website.

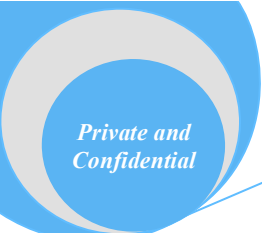
## 8) *Payment*
